## POOL PARTY INFORMATION


In order to allow flexibility with accommodating pool parties it is ESSENTIAL for members to communicate directly with the pool manager when scheduling events.

### Daytime Gatherings

 All parties, private or not, must be prearranged through pool management. The maximum number of guests allowed for gatherings held during general swim hours is 25. Members can bring up to 10 guests at no additional charge. If members are bringing between 11-25 guests they will be asked to pay for a lifeguard hired specifically for their group at the rate of \$16.50/hour.

- **These parties must be scheduled with the pool manager at least one week in advance.**
- Members will pay the \$30 facility fee and the appropriate deposit.

### Private Parties

 If you are planning to have a party with more than 25 guests you need to schedule a private party after or before general swimming hours. **These parties must also be scheduled with the pool manager at least 1 week in advance.** Private parties may be held between 8-10pm.

If you are having a private party you need to sign a contract and write three separate checks:


- \$75 or \$150 deposit  
Payable to Westfield Pool
- \$20 or \$30 or \$50 fee  
Payable to Westfield Pool
- \$16.50/hour/guard  
Payable to Splash  
(2 guard minimum)

## SWIMMING LESSONS

Welcome to the Splash Water Wise Program. Because space in this letter is limited, all participants will receive a detailed information handout upon registering for the program at the pool. This handout will address class cancellations, refunds, specific class requirements, etc. Please speak with the pool manager or any swim lesson instructor concerning questions you have or to verify the proper placement for your swimmer.  Classes cost \$30-\$40 per student per session. *Payment is due upon registration.*

 Classes run for 25-40 minutes between 9:00am and 11:00am Monday-Friday the first week and Monday-Thursday the second week. *This leaves the last Friday open for a make-up day.*

## CHILDREN & SAFETY

**Parents: Please remember you are ultimately responsible for the safety of your children.**

For the safety and enjoyment of everyone, we insist that the pool and staff not be used in place of childcare. The Board of Directors recommends that children be 10 years old or older to be at the facility without adult supervision. All children left at the pool unaccompanied must be able to pass a swim test conducted by the lifeguard staff. In the event the pool must be closed due to unforeseen circumstances, unattended children must have phone numbers on hand where an emergency contact person can be reached.

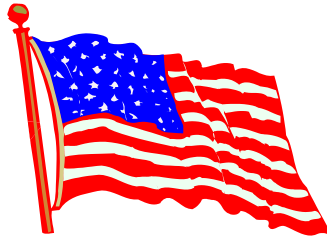
**Swimmers who are dependent on floatation devices to swim must be accompanied (within one arms length) by an adult swimmer who is also in the water.**

***NO DIVING IN WATER LESS THAN FIVE FEET DEEP.***

***HANDS MUST ENTER THE WATER FIRST FOR ANY HEAD FIRST ENTRY.***

### ATTENTION SWIMMERS:

- **Bullying, disrespectful language, or profanity on pool grounds will not be tolerated. Parents are responsible for teaching their children these rules.**
- For the safety of all pool users the diving well and diving board usage will be monitored by the staff and will be limited to the following:
  - The first half of the hour use of the diving board will be allowed. Recreational swimming in the diving well will be prohibited.
  - The second half of the hour the diving well will be free for recreational swimming while the diving board will be off limits.
- Diving allowed only in the diving well.
- Hands must enter the water first for any head first entry.

The lifeguards will be hosting games and giving away prizes during the party from 12pm-4pm.

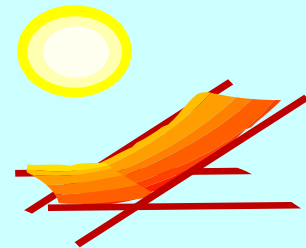
### WATER FITNESS

Water aerobics classes will be held Monday, Wednesday and Friday mornings from 6-7am June 2 through August 15. Please ask the lifeguards for details on our aqua fitness classes this season.

### POOL ADMITTANCE POLICY

Westfield will be using a computerized check-in system this year to monitor pool usage and memberships. Please check in with the lifeguards each time you enter the facility. At the request of membership the staff will conduct random membership checks to ensure only pool members are using your facility.

### GUESTS

Lifetime, Family, and Limited memberships will receive complimentary guest passes. Please remember the following guidelines when bringing guests to the pool:

- **All guests will receive and must wear a wrist band upon entering the facility.**
- All guests must be accompanied by a member.
- Family guest pass can be used by one family; or one guest pass per friend.
- The maximum number of guests allowed for gatherings held during general swim hours is 10.
