SWIMMING LESSONS

According to the CDC children ages 1-4 who participate in formal swimming lessons are 88% less likely to drown. Let us help your children learn to be safe and strong swimmers! Registration for lessons is available at <https://splashpoolservices.com/swimming-lessons/> after May 8th.

Group Lesson Session Dates:

- Session 1 June 2-June 12
- Session 2 June 16- June 26
- Session 3 July 7-July 17
- Session 4 July 21-July 31

The second Friday of each session will only be used for make-up classes in the event of a full class cancellation.

Group lessons are participation based. Classes will only run if there are at least 3 swimmers registered for each full session. If the class you registered for does not run due to low enrollment you will have the option of applying your enrollment to a future session or receiving a refund. Classes run between 9:15am and 11:00am each session. Specific class times are set prior to each session. You will be notified of your specific class time(s) no later than the Saturday prior to each session.

Private and semi-private lessons are also available. These are 1:1 or 2-3:1 lessons that are scheduled at your convenience with an individual instructor. You choose the time, you set the goals!

NON-SWIMMER WRISTBAND POLICY

Drownings happen quickly and quietly even when lifeguards and parents are present. To prevent drownings, it is imperative that parents and guardians actively watch their children in and around water, even when lifeguards are on duty. Splash Pool Services and Westfield are pleased to announce a strategy to prevent drowning. All “non-swimmers” will be required to wear wristbands indicating that they must have a guardian within one arms reach. Wristbands are a great visual aid indicating swimming ability. They quickly and easily help lifeguards and bystanders identify which swimmers require close supervision.

All swimmers under the age of 10 must swim one length of the pool safely to swim without a wristband. *That age was determined since it's the cut off for swimming unsupervised at Westfield.* If they cannot pass the swim test, they must wear a wristband and be actively supervised by a guardian who is within one arms reach of them in the water. Guardians must be at least 14 years old. Swimming ability will be noted in the membership database and non-swimmer wristbands will be given to those who need them each time they enter the facility. Swimmers may retake the swim test throughout the summer to prove their ability to stay safe on their own.

Although our lifeguards are provided to assist you with supervising your swimmers, please remember that you are ultimately responsible for the safety of your family and your guests. There is no substitute for your ACTIVE SUPERVISION!

POOL RULES

- Private Pool. Membership Required. No Trespassing. Swim at your own risk
- Parents are responsible for the safety of their children at all times.
- The judgment of the lifeguard on duty shall supersede any pool rule.
- No hypoxic training or breath holding exercises.
- Diving is permitted in the diving well only. Hands must enter the water first for all headfirst entries.
- No running, glass, tobacco products or alcohol.
- Flotation devices are permitted at the lifeguard's discretion.
- A restbreak will be called 10 minutes to each hour. Infants 2 or younger may accompany adult guardians in the water if they always remain in contact with the adult.
- All nontoelet trained swimmers must wear specially formulated swimming diapers in both pools.
- No lifeguard on duty in the wader pool. Swimmers must be supervised at all times.

GUEST PASSES

Your family and friends are welcome to enjoy the pool with you! **Each membership household is permitted to bring up to 10 guests without approval from the manager. You may not coordinate maxing out your guest passes with other memberships without prior approval through the pool manager. Your group may be turned away if the event wasn't prearranged with management.**

Guest passes will be distributed as follows:

Lifetime Membership: 20 complimentary individual guest passes + 1 family guest passes

Summer Family Membership: 10 complimentary individual guest passes

Summer Limited Membership: 5 complimentary individual guest passes

Additional passes can be purchased for \$20 per 5 pass card.

Family guest passes can be used by one family; or one guest pass per friend.



POOL PARTIES AND GUESTS

Please schedule all parties and/or group gatherings (daytime or private) through the pool manager **AT LEAST ONE WEEK IN ADVANCE.**

Your group may be turned away if you don't have prior approval through management.

Daytime Gatherings

Gatherings with over 10 people held during general swim hours must be prearranged. Hosts will be asked to pay for a lifeguard hired specifically for their group at the rate of \$30/hour in addition to the facility fee and deposit.

The maximum number of guests allowed during general swim hours is 25 for up to 3 hours.

Private Parties

Gatherings of more than 25 guests are permitted between 8pm-10pm any night of the week except during Family Nights Swim and holidays.

The following fees apply to pool gatherings:

Deposit—Payable to Westfield Pool:

\$75 daytime

\$150 after hours

Facility Fee—Payable to Westfield Pool:

\$20/hr. clubhouse only

\$30 pool without clubhouse

\$50 pool and clubhouse

Lifeguards—Payable to Splash: \$30/hour/guard (3 guard minimum)

Ask the pool manager how you can pay online!

INCLEMENT WEATHER AND LIGHTNING

If the outside temperature is below 65 degrees the pool will be closed and the lifeguard will leave the facility (no lifeguard on duty). A sign will be posted on the gate to inform members of the closure. *Follow us on Facebook and Instagram to stay current on pool closures.*

In the event of a thunder and/or lightning storm,



the lifeguards will adhere to the **National Lightning Safety Institute** policy & require all swimmers to exit the water AND pool grounds for 30 minutes after the last sound of thunder.

If the storm hinders swimming for 60 minutes, or if the bottom of the pool cannot be seen due to heavy rain, the pool will close until the storm has subsided.

For the safety of pool members and their guests the staff has the authority to close the facility during any thunder or lightning storm.
